## Advancing the Great Commission Together

Dear Ministry Partner,

We cannot thank you enough for the part you play in fulfilling the Great Commission. Your prayers, generosity, and sacrificial support fuel the mission to reach the unreached, make disciples, and equip leaders to multiply.

Through your partnership, LIFE Ministry Uganda is expanding its reach across the nation. In every region, we are establishing movements of multiplying disciples so that *everyone in Uganda knows someone who truly follows Jesus*.

This past July, we had the privilege of taking the Gospel to the West Nile region, with a special focus on reaching the unreached and least-reached people groups. What we witnessed was nothing short of God's power at work. This newsletter offers a glimpse of how God moved, the lives that were transformed, and the exciting steps ahead as we continue to make Jesus and His mission known to everyone, everywhere.

## WHAT GOD DID IN WEST NILE

With the immense support and partnership of local churches, communities, and individuals, the mission in West Nile impacted thousands with the Gospel! For 10 days, 175 missionaries shared the Gospel in villages, towns, schools, and churches in Obongi, Moyo, Madi Okollo, Koboko, Arua, and Zombo. People listened eagerly and gave their lives to Jesus.

During this mission, we launched *Walking With Jesus* in Lugbara, giving people the opportunity to encounter Jesus in their heart language. We also launched FamilyLife ministry in Arua to strengthen and transform families, and began ministry on four new campuses and two high schools.

By the end of the mission, 52 Jesus Film shows had been conducted, and 29,520 people had the opportunity to hear the good news of Jesus. Out of these, 17,690 gave their lives to Christ. To disciple the new believers, we established 23 new faith communities and trained 423 people to continue sharing the Gospel and multiply these communities.

## Stories That Still Move Us

Statistics can give us a picture of the mission, but the real impact is found in the lives transformed. Behind every number is a name, a family, a testimony of God at work. Here are a few glimpses of those stories.

One young Muslim woman in **Obongi** had dreamt of Jesus months earlier, smiling and embracing her. When the Gospel was shared with her during the mission, she realized that dream was God drawing her to Himself. That day, she gave her life to Christ.

In **Koboko**, a man named David interrupted a Gospel presentation, shouting, *"I'm a drunkard and a marijuana addict—I need Jesus!"* He prayed to receive Christ on the spot, went home, and sold his alcohol business the very same day.

And in **Zombo**, a young girl who was preparing to abort her baby chose life both for herself and her child after hearing about the love of Christ.

Again in Koboko, a family of eight came to the missionaries in desperation. They had been tormented by intense demonic oppression. Among them was a woman so weak that she had to be carried. With faith, the team prayed over her, and to everyone's amazement, demons were cast out. The bedridden woman rose to her feet, strong, free, and restored. That day, two of her relatives gave their lives to Christ, declaring Him as Lord.

These are only a handful of the countless lives touched, each one testifying to God's power at work and a reminder of the many more hearts still waiting to be reached with the Gospel.
